

## **Social Security Benefits Statement**

Please visit <http://ssa.gov/> to verify the proper reporting of your income subject to social security.

We suggest visiting this site on an annual basis. You will need to create an account and then you can sign in each year and all your information will be right there. You are able to check your annual wages reported as well as your benefit amount at normal age of retirement, early retirement and delayed retirement.

Also be aware that you may be entitled to benefits based on the earnings of your spouse. The benefits statement can provide all of that information.

Be sure as you approach 65 years of age, even if you don't sign up for social security, that you sign up for Medicare.
